STATEMENT

13 June 1910:

I was flying ship 031 as walst gurner, on the 12th of June 1944 on a combat operational mission over France, when a call came over the interpasse that a ship had been knocked down. It came past my right waist window. I could see it didn't have any cockpit on it. It was blown off at the bulkhead between the navigator's compartment and the cockpit. It fell about 2000 feet, and then a fire spread slowly over the wings. I watched it go down, and saw two (2) chutes come out. It went behind a cloud out of sight at about 2000 feet. I didn't see it crash, but saw it burning on the ground after we had finished oug bomb run.


